MISSION PARTNERS

OHC has been serving families in the Quiche village for decades. OHC Minister Pat Hile, his wife Carol, and their family served as fulltime missionaries in this region many years ago. Through the years they have faithfully maintained relationships, developed leaders, and formed ongoing partnerships with rural churches. OHC also partners with Missions Frontier, an organization that serves communities through partnerships with local pastors, to provide relief efforts and developmental projects. We will construct village homes for Quiche widows and families who are unable to afford such a home. The team will also share the hope of Jesus to children and adults through Bible drama, praise, crafts, and activities. Another major area of service is the medical outreach ministry to villages.

TRIP DETAILS

Lodging: Casa Del Rey is a hotel located on the mountainside overlooking the city of Chichicastenango. Each room is double or triple occupancy with a large area room with a fireplace and sitting room. The hotel has showers, with hot water, and bathroom facilities included in each room.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner are included in the trip cost. Dinner is buffet-style, including soup, salad, main course, and dessert.

Trip Orientation: We will have several Team Meetings prior to our trip. We will provide you with a Team Informational Packet at the first Team Meeting. Team Meetings are required and will focus on building team unity, learning about the culture of our designated country, discussion, and planning for our in-country service.

ITINERARY (Tentative)

June 5 (Travel Day): Depart San Antonio early; arrive in Guatemala around noon. Load onto the bus for a 3-4-hour bus ride to the mountain areas of Chichicastenango and settle into Casa Del Rey. Team orientation after arrival.

June 6-8 (Ministry Days): Minister to different areas with medical, children/adult ministry, and widow home construction. This is a team effort between local Quiche leaders and OHC team.

June 9 (Rest Day): Rest and enjoy Chichicastenango where we experience and enjoy a true "open air market day."

June 10 (Ministry Day): Village ministry (same as June 6-8 above).

June 11 (Travel Day): Depart Casa Del Rey and travel toward our departure city of Guatemala City. In route we will visit Lake Atitlan area and stay in Antigua for the night. We depart to Guatemala City early Sunday morning.

June 12 (Travel Day): Depart Guatemala, fly home to San Antonio, arrive late evening.
