Christ will one day return and judge all people. (2 Thess. 1:8-10; 1 Thess. 4:13-18)
Believers will be welcomed into God's presence in Heaven. Unbelievers will be in Hell, separated from God's presence.

1. Christ is coming to _____ his people.

"The Arrival of the Son of Man will take place in times like Noah's. Before the great flood everyone was carrying on as usual, having a good time right up to the day Noah boarded the ark. They knew nothing—until the flood hit and swept everything away." (Matt. 24:37-39 MSG)

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout. (1 Thess. 4:16 NKJV)

2. Christ is coming to _____ all people.

He will be King and sit on his great throne. (Matt. 25:31 NCV)

Every knee will bow to the name of Jesus—everyone in heaven, on earth, and under the earth. And everyone will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord. (Phil. 2:10-11 NCV)

Nothing impure will ever enter [heaven], nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of Life. (Rev. 21:27 NIV)
